

Ordinance No. 2021-03
An Ordinance to Lower Speed Limit on Town Highway—17th Drive

The Dakota Town Board, Waushara County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting, and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limit on 17th Drive in the Town of Dakota as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., effective January 1, 2022, the speed limit on 17th Drive between Chicago Road and Cottonville Lane will be reduced from 55 mph to 45 mph.
- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., the town chairperson or his designee shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described location on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highway in violation of the above-noted speed limit. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. Stats.

This ordinance is effective on January 1, 2022, by which time this ordinance shall have been properly posted and/or published as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
